

CONTINUED MEETING DUBOIS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

NOVEMBER 26, 2018

The continued monthly meeting of the Dubois County Commissioners was held in the Commissioners/Council Room of the Courthouse Annex in Jasper, Indiana, beginning at 8:30 a.m. (EST) on November 26, 2018. Present were Commissioners Nick Hostetter, Chad A. Blessinger and Elmer Brames. Also present were County Auditor Kathleen M. Hopf, and County Attorney Arthur C. Nordhoff, Jr. A quorum was declared present and the meeting was opened for business by President Hostetter.

RE: COUNTY ATTORNEY

The principal purpose of the meeting was consideration of replacement for current County Attorney Arthur C. Nordhoff, Jr. Attorney Nordhoff previously resigned as County Attorney effective December 31, 2018 after serving 27 years in said capacity.

Commissioner Blessinger stated that after discussion with other possible candidates he was in favor of engagement of Greg Schnarr as County attorney effective January 1, 2019, at the same compensation as that received by Mr. Nordhoff. Extensive discussion followed as to whether Schnarr would also receive Public Employee Retirement. Further discussion will occur, and Schnarr will be advised by the Commissioners as to whether his position would be that of employee or contracted attorney.

RE: PROSECUTOR OFFICE POSITION

Prosecutor Anthony Quinn appeared to inform the Commissioners that one of his deputy prosecutors will be leaving Dubois County and an additional employee will be employed. He questioned the availability of additional space for his offices. Various locations within the Annex were discussed, along with locations available in other public buildings and other offices which might be relocated. Further discussion will be held on the subject.
