

DUBOIS COUNTY COUNCIL

DECEMBER 14, 2009

The Dubois County Council conducted its monthly meeting on December 14, 2009, at 4:30 pm, in the Council Chambers of the Courthouse Annex. Present at the meeting were Board members Gregory A. Kendall, Jerry R. Hunefeld, Scott J. Knies, Mark A. Brescher, Donna L. Schroeder, Bonnie J. Luebbehusen, Martha A. Wehr, and Auditor Janet L. Sendelweck. President Kendall asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes of the last meeting. On motion by Bonnie J. Luebbehusen, seconded by Donna L. Schroeder, the minutes were approved as written. The motion carried unanimously.

RE: SOUTHERN HILLS – ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION

Auditor Sendelweck presented a request for an additional appropriation from Southern Hills in the amount of \$10,500. The additional appropriation has been advertised. On motion by Scott J. Knies, seconded by Martha A. Wehr, the additional appropriation was unanimously approved.

RE: TEMPORARY COURTHOUSE CUSTODIAN

The Commissioners recommended the salary for the temporary Courthouse Custodian Scott Hopf be set at 20% of the current Custodian's salary. The temporary Custodian will work 40 hours per week from November 30, 2009, until he becomes full time Custodian on January 1, 2010. On motion by Mark A. Brescher, seconded by Jerry R. Hunefeld, the Council unanimously approved the salary.

RE: TEMPORARY SOLID WASTE DIRECTOR

The Commissioners recommended the salary for the temporary Solid Waste Director Toni Lubbers be set at 10% of the current Solid Waste Director's salary. The temporary Director will work 29 hours per week from December 14, 2009, until she becomes full time Director on January 1, 2010. On motion by Jerry R. Hunefeld, seconded by Martha A. Wehr, the Council unanimously approved the salary.
